



Half Term Curriculum Overview

Year 2 Spring 2

English

- Our fiction unit is based on a book called My name is not Refugee
- We will begin the spring term with our poetry unit Night Sounds
- There will be daily writing opportunities to develop grammar skills and handwriting.
- Some children will continue to access RWInc phonics
- In Grammar we will be looking at past and present tense, using subordination because, when so that, using correct punctuation including apostrophes.
- Forming all our letters correctly using the correct orientation and size.

PE

- PE is on a Tuesday and a Friday this half term. We will be focussing on Games- Net and Wall games, striking and Fielding

ICT

This half term the focus is on Data and Information Pictograms

Poem a day

- This half term we will be looking at learning a poem a week off by heart and performing it to other classes within school.

Art/Science/Geography

- In Art we will be teaching children to explore and create maps through various art forms such as drawing, printing, 3D art.
- In Science our topic is 'Plants' The children will learn what plants need to stay healthy. They will closely observe the inside of a seed and the Life cycle of a plant. The children will carry out their own investigations as what plants need to grow well.
- In Geography our topic is At the Farm. We will be exploring what farms are and why they are important, the features of a farm, using maps and symbols to navigate a farm and looking at how seasonal changes can affect life on the farm.

- Times tables 10x and 5x 2x
- Finding equal groups
- Dividing by 2, 10, 5
- Measuring in centimetres and metres

RE/PSHE

- RE – What is a Prophet? Why does Easter bring hope to many Christians?.
- Our PSHE focus is Rights and Respect
