RE—Our RE lessons we will cover the unit entitled— What Happens When We Die? This unit explores the concept of death, including various beliefs and practices surrounding it.

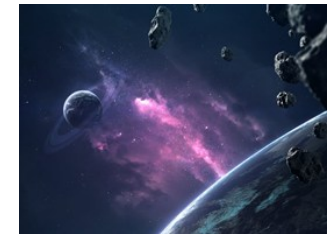
Science:
