

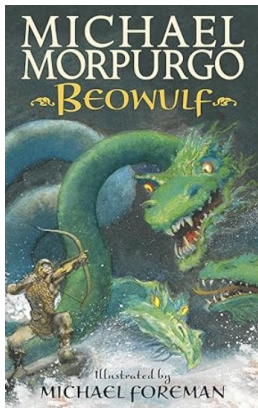
English:

We will start with a week of poetry about the moon. The children will then write their own poem about the moon using a range of techniques.

We will then look at the story of Beowulf using the novel by Micael Morpurgo. After studying the book and completing lots of smaller writing tasks the children will write a further adventure for Beowulf .

There will be weekly spellings to learn and a spelling test on Fridays.

The spelling we will be working on are words with 'silent' letters, modal verbs, words ending in 'ment' and adverbs of possibility and frequency



Geography:

Our topic this half term centres around South American countries, their cultures and climates.

YEAR 5 - AUTUMN SECOND HALF

Maths

We will continue to complete daily times tables tests. There will also be a piece of maths arithmetic work to complete at home each week. Our topics this half term are multiplication and division, fractions and geometry.

Multiplication and division—we will look at factors, multiplies, prime numbers, square numbers and cube numbers. We will also look at multiplying and dividing by 10 100 and 1000.

Fractions—we will look at ordering fractions, improper fractions and mixed numbers, converting fractions as well as adding and subtracting different types of fractions.

Geometry—we will use grids and geometry to create different types of stars.

PE—This half term we will concentrate on movement and dance. We will look at the Halloween season and our topic of rainforests. This lesson will be Monday afternoons. On Thursday afternoon, the class will continue swimming.

RE—Our RE topic is Christianity, and the question of Why doesn't Christianity always look the same?

Science:

Properties and changes of materials.

We will look at how materials are chosen for use based on their properties, how materials change their state and we will look at reversible and irreversible changes of materials.



Art and design: Interactive installation. .

We will look at 3d art and sculpture.

Computing—Video production. We will look at using storyboards and creating videos.
