

English: This term our English work will focus around Jo Hoestlandt's 'Star of Fear, Star of Hope'. Children will write their own story with a flash-back from another character's point of view, as well as writing a non-chronological report to link with their History work on World Wars, conflict and refugees.

Computing: In this unit learners explore how data is transferred over the internet. Learners initially focus on addressing, before they move on to the makeup and structure of data packets.

French: In French the children will learn the days of the week, months of the year and will learn how to say different animals and if they have a pet.

History:

This term our History work will be based around World War 2: What was the impact of World War 2 on the people of Britain?



YEAR 6 - AUTUMN 1

Maths

In Year 6, children will have weekly Arithmetic lessons, focusing on speedy recall and mental maths.

The remaining Maths lessons will focus on building knowledge in all other areas, including:

Place Value—ordering and rounding numbers, including decimals, multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000.

Fractions and decimals—equivalent fractions and converting fractions to decimals.

Properties of number—prime numbers, square numbers, square roots and number sequences.

Formal methods of multiplication and division

PE Children will have a PE lesson on a Monday as well as Run A Mile throughout the week.

RE This half-term's focus will be 'Why does religion look different around the world?'

Science:

This term our Science work will focus on Evolution and Inheritance. We will be looking at how humans and animals have changed over-time and adapted to their environments. We will also be designing and creating our own species of animal showing how it is adapted to its environment.
