

## YEAR 6 - AUTUMN 2

### **English:**

This term our English work will focus around a non-fiction text called 'Can we Save the Tiger?'. Children will create a hybrid-information text.

We will also look at Performance Poetry, with children writing and performing their own poems.

In Grammar, we will be studying the Active and Passive voice, as well as the use of dashes, hyphens, colons and semi colons.

Children should continue to read regularly at home and practice spellings.

### **Geography:**

This term our Geography work will be based around North America. We will be looking at geographical features, climates, time zones and capital cities of North America.



### **Maths**

In Year 6, children will have weekly Arithmetic lessons, focusing on speedy recall and mental maths.

The remaining Maths lessons will focus on building knowledge in all other areas, including:

**Fractions**— finding equivalent and simplified fractions. Adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing fractions.

**Measurement** — we will look at different units of measure (metric and imperial) and converting between the two.

**PE** - Children will have a PE lesson on a Monday as well as Run A Mile throughout the week.

**RE** - This half-term's theme is 'Why does religion look different around the world?'

**PSHE** — 'Valuing Differences'

**French** - 'As-tu un animal?' Do you have a pet?

### **Science:**

- This term our Science work will focus on Light. We will be able to explain that we see things because of light travelling between light sources and our eyes.
- Understand that light travels in straight lines.
- Explain that we see objects because they give out or reflect light into our eyes.
- Use the idea of light travelling in straight lines to explain why objects and shadows of objects are the same shape.

**DT**—Navigating the Digital World—looking at 3D printing and designing our own models.
