Intent

Our Art and Design curriculum nurtures creativity, imagination and visual literacy, inspiring pupils to think like artists and designers. Through Kapow, pupils gain confidence to experiment, express ideas and appreciate art as a form of human expression across cultures and time. The curriculum is inclusive and ambitious, enabling all pupils to enjoy, create and respond to art meaningfully.

Implementation

We follow the Kapow Art and Design scheme, which provides a clear progression of skills and knowledge. Lessons are practical, engaging and supported by strong teacher resources. Pupils explore drawing, painting, sculpture, craft, design and digital media while learning about artists and cultural influences. Reflection and self-evaluation are built in to help pupils develop their artistic voice.

Impact

Pupils become confident, creative and reflective artists. They demonstrate growing technical skills, originality and understanding of art's role in society. By the end of primary school, pupils are equipped with the knowledge and enthusiasm to continue exploring art and design with curiosity and confidence.
