Our Intent

We want every child to enjoy music, develop a lifelong love for it, and grow in confidence through music-making. Music sparks creativity, builds community, and helps our pupils *Reach for the Stars*—whether they become future conductors or West End performers.

Our Implementation

Music is taught weekly across all year groups, following the National Curriculum and using the Charanga scheme (recommended by Lancashire Music Hub). Pupils:

- Perform, listen to, and evaluate music from different times, cultures, and styles.
- Learn to sing, compose, and play instruments—including glockenspiels and others via Lancashire Music Service.
- Explore musical elements like pitch, tempo, dynamics, and notation.

Singing is central to our school life, with weekly practices and annual participation in *Let's Go Sing*. Live performances, school productions, and choir clubs enrich our curriculum and build confidence.

Our Impact

Children leave us with a strong appreciation for music, a sense of achievement, and lasting memories of making music together. They develop musical skills, creativity, and teamwork—carrying the joy of music with them into the future.
