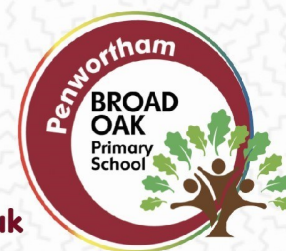

## Who are we?

We hold both our breakfast and after school clubs in the Blue Room. This is situated in the extended part of the school building, in between Reception and Year 1 classrooms. Our clubs are run by, Mrs Roberts, Mrs Doyle Miss Hodson and Mrs Lawless , who work in school as full time teaching assistants.

## What do we offer?

Breakfast and After School club begins from the moment your child attends. We will take your children to class at the beginning of the school day and collect them from the designated areas in the afternoon for our After School Club.

Children are provided with a variety of cereals and toast along with fresh fruit, juice, milk or water at Breakfast club.

During After School Club they will be able to choose their snack, which they are encouraged to help themselves to. The snack is laid out and the children choose to eat what they like, under supervision from a member of staff. Snacks vary daily, but fresh fruit and fruit juice/water is always readily available. If your child suffers from any food allergies, please let us know when completing the registration form.

Breakfast Club starts at 8.00am. After School Club runs until 5.45pm. As places are limited, all sessions must be booked and paid for in advance. To do this please go online, if you have any problems please call into the club ,school office or call 01772 749511.

## What do we want to achieve at care club?

- ICT suite, here the children can surf the internet. All internet usage is monitored through our E safety.
