This will give you a brief insight into which areas of the curriculum your child will be studying in Autumn 1.

English	Poetry: The Song of Hiawatha Outcome: Pupils write a selection of a narrative poem about water Queen of the Falls by Chris Van Allsburg, Good Night Stories for Rebel Girls by Elena Favilli and Francesca Cavallo Outcome: Recount- write a series of diary entries Greater Depth Series of diary entries including her viewpoint on other characters
Maths	Our first unit of work in Maths will be place value. Where we will be looking at Roman numerals and hundreds of thousands. This will lead us on to our addition and subtraction units where we will build up on using the column method and real life problems. Whilst in Year 5 we will continue to work really hard on our times tables, it would be great if you could do this at home as well.
Science	Materials: Mixtures and separation, will be our unit for Autumn 1. Please see the knowledge organizer on Seesaw for a more in depth look at what we will be covering.
History	This half term we will be looking at our fourth unit of British History: Were the Vikings raiders, traders or something else?
