



Half Term Curriculum Overview

Year 2 Autumn 1

English

- We will be starting our English with a poetry unit called Zebra Question.
- Our fiction unit is based on a book called Look up
- There will be daily writing opportunities to develop grammar skills and handwriting.
- Some children will continue to access RWInc phonics
- In Grammar we will be looking at joining sentences with and, because, using capital letters and full stops and expanded noun phrases

Art/History/Science

- In Art we will be exploring Drawing and our understanding of tone and texture.
- In History we will be exploring how schools are different in the past from today. We will finish our unit by having our own Victorian Day.
- In Science our topic is Living things: Habitats. We will be identifying what living things need to survive by exploring the Life Processes shared by all living things

- Place Value
- Number bonds to 100
- Write numbers to 100
- Recognise tens and ones
- Partition numbers to 100
- Count in 2s 5s 10s and 3s
- Addition and subtraction of 1 and 2 digit numbers.
- 10 more 10 less
- Add and subtract 10s

PE

- PE is on a Monday and a Friday this half term.
- The children are to come in their PE kits on these days.

RE/PSHE

- Our PSHE focus is Me and My relationships

ICT

This half term the focus is on Information technology around us.

Music

- All the learning is focused around one song: Hands, Feet, Heart -We will Listen & Appraise other styles of music and continue to embed the interrelated dimensions of music through games, singing and playing.
